



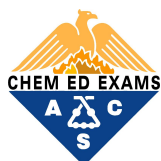

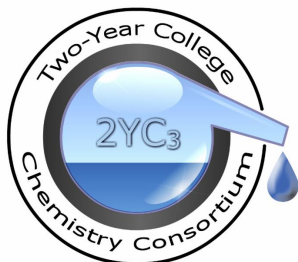
WELCOME to the University of Notre Dame (ND) and the 2018 BCCE -- Chemical Education is Golden!

Please take a few minutes to read through this email as it contains information that will assist you in navigating the conference and the ND campus.

1) You may want to download the ACS Meetings App and load the BCCE conference in the app. It will have the most up-to-date information on talks, workshops, meetings and their locations. You can also use the app to build your personal conference schedule. Instructions for downloading the app can be found at <http://bcce2018.org/Program/bccemeetingapp.html>

2) South Bend Airport shuttles to ND - Due to restrictions in shuttle licensing and approval for airport service, the BCCE is unable to provide shuttle service for the conference. Taxi service is available to/from South Bend International Airport for \$15 each way. Uber and Lyft also service the SBN airport. 3) Chicago Airport transportation to ND from both Midway and O'Hare Airports is available from [Coach USA](http://CoachUSA.com) (aka Airport Supersaver). 4) Registration check-in will be available in [McKenna Hall](#) (#1079 on the map) beginning Sunday morning at 7 am. Look for the BCCE feather flags identifying buildings and locations. Please park in the Bookstore Lot (free, 1 hr parking) and walk to McKenna Hall. Do not park in the loop in front of McKenna Hall -- this is a tow zone and is for bus/shuttles only.

5) Parking on campus -- we have arranged for [free parking on campus](#). Make sure to pick up a permit at check-in and display that on your dashboard during the conference. Park in the appropriate lots only as shown on the [parking map](#) or you may be issued a ticket and/or be towed.

6) If you have any special needs -- on campus transportation, vision/hearing accommodations, access to lactation rooms, etc., please send a message to bcce2018@nd.edu with your need and contact information and we will do our best to arrange for your needs.

7) We will be running a continuous shuttle loop between McKenna Hall and the [conference hotels](#). Schedules will be posted in McKenna Hall and will be in your conference packet.

8) For all the tekkies, there is [free wifi access](#) on campus (ND-guest network). If your campus uses the eduroam network, then you will have that network access on the ND campus as well.

9) [Food, glorious food](#) -- there will be lots of that during the conference as well. Check out what we have planned for you during the conference. In addition to all of this, we will also have all day beverage and snack service during the conference.
